The Pont du Gard is the tallest Roman bridge aqueduct in the world built by the Romans 2000 years ago in only 5 years.

## A BRIEF HISTORY

This masterpiece of impressive architecture, classified as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985, has given the inhabitants of the city of Nîmes high-pressure running water for 5 centuries.

In a breathtaking natural setting, this stone colossus is one of the highest ancient bridges in the world.

### THE GREAT ODYSSEY

Testimony to the engineering skills of an entire civilisation, with its impressive architecture the Pont du Gard is the largest ancient bridge in the world. Mainly known for its exceptionally large aqueduct, the Pont du Gard Site is also famous for the beauty and diversity of its natural environment. At the gateway to the Gardon Gorges in the heart of the Mediterranean garrigue scrubland, this Roman masterpiece reveals all the secrets of its history through a guided tour that will take you to the 3rd floor of the bridge.
